

## UniNE Institute of English Studies. First-year students 2017

If **English** is your **pilier principal**, you normally need to attend three first-year modules in the first year of your studies at the Institute of English Studies: the module *Language (PP1)*, the module *Literature (PP2)* and the module *Linguistics (PP3)*. The following information will tell you how to sign up for the different classes.

If you are studying **English** as **pilier secondaire**, you will attend the three modules *Language (PS1)*, *Literature (PS2)* and *Linguistics (PS3)* in the second and third year of your studies. Therefore you should only follow the signing up instructions below if you are in your second or third year.

### **Language (PP1, PS1)**

Practical Language is offered in three identical sections.

- Practical Language (section 1) Tuesday 10-12 Room B.1.01
- Practical Language (section 2) Wednesday 10-12 Room B.1.49
- Practical Language (section 3) Thursday 10-12 Room B.2.61

**For Practical Language all students need to sign up for ONE of the three sections on September 15. The number of places per group cannot exceed 20-22 students.**

### **Literature (PP2, PS2)**

In the module *Literature (PP2, PS2)*, you will attend the mandatory introductory lecture

- Introduction to Literature in English I : Narrative fiction and drama Monday 10-11 Room R.E.48

and one of the three identical sections of the "Literature and Writing Workshop".

- Literature and Writing Workshop (section 1) Monday 14-16 Room B.1.49
- Literature and Writing Workshop (section 2) Tuesday 10-12 Room B.1.49
- Literature and Writing Workshop (section 3) Thursday 10-12 Room B.1.49

**For the Literature and Writing Workshop you need to sign up in room B.1.49 between 10 and 12 on Tuesday, September 19. You also need to bring along CHF 5.- to purchase the course reader. The lecture and regular workshop classes start in the second week of term.**

### **Linguistics (PP3, PS3)**

In the module *Linguistics (PP3, PS3)*, you will attend the mandatory introductory lecture

- Introduction to English Linguistics Monday 11-12 Room R.E.48

and one of the identical sections of the "English Linguistics Workshop" (see sign up procedure below).

- English Linguistics Workshop (section 1) Monday 12-13 Room R.O.14
- English Linguistics Workshop (section 2) Monday 13-14 Room R.O.14
- English Linguistics Workshop (section 3) Wednesday 12-13 Room R.E.46
- English Linguistics Workshop (section 4) Wednesday 13-14 Room R.E.46

**The sign-up for the English Linguistics Workshop will take place during the first *Introduction to English Linguistics* lecture on Monday the 25<sup>th</sup> of September. All classes start in the second week of term.**

For English Phonetics and Phonology, all students attend the lecture

- English Phonetics and Phonology (lecture) Friday 9-10 LBMA

and one of the two identical workshops (see sign up procedure below).

- English Phonetics and Phonology (workshop 1) Friday 10-11 Room R.E.42
- English Phonetics and Phonology (workshop 2) Friday 11-12 Room R.E.42

**For the English Phonetics and Phonology workshop you need to sign up in the first lecture on Friday, September 22.**
