

"Microbes go to school" is growing

The year 2021 was a very important year for us. We did not only enlarge the program and worked with six classes in spring, but we also had the opportunity to summarise the activities in a new publication which has already captured the attention of the community.

Also, the creators of the program were awarded the "Best teaching" award of the Credit Suisse in November 2021. This is an important recognition of the importance of this type of teaching activities to get the university outside its doors and to spread scientific knowledge in society. This prize was coordinated with our first successful launching of a crowd funding to continue the financing of the program.

Finally, a new partnership with the Educational Service of the Canton allowed the program to reach new partners. Schools answered the call and we have now a database of more than 40 teachers/classes that will be participating to the program in the years to come.

The program will continue growing and expanding and for this we will still need your support.

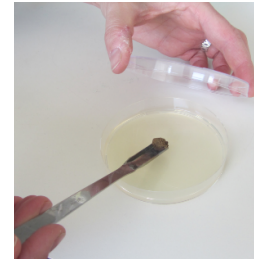
