Museomics as a window into long-term insect population decline

Museomics is a fast-growing field of evolutionary biology that leverages the richness of historical museum collections. The temporal context of their collection, forming genuine time series, allow to investigate recent evolutionary trajectories. We gathered a large sampling across Switzerland and throughout the 20th century for seven insect species to investigate the recent large-scale decline of insects.
