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The role of life history and movement in spatial population synchrony: Theoretical and empirical investigations

Species have unique traits that determine how sensitive their population dynamics are to environments.

I present investigations into a suite of life history traits which dictate:

- 1) the environments that different populations are exposed to and
- 2) how population dynamics are expected to respond to these environments (i.e., sensitivity).
