Gaze Tracking across Species: How Social Cognition Is Situated within Context and Collectivity

A key challenge in animal cognition research is balancing natural responses with experimental control. Focusing on anticipatory looking in great apes and gaze following in birds, I show how integrating gaze tracking with experimental and high-tech approaches reveals how social cognition operates contextually and collectively across species and within group settings.
