The WBSC is responsible for international governance, competitions, development programmes and the promotion of ethical and integrity standards across the global Baseball/Softball community.

Main Responsibilities

- conducting legal research and analysis and drafting summaries of research findings;
- analysing and assisting in the drafting of legal documents, including Statutes, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, and contracts;
- assisting with integrity investigations and related activities;
- supporting legal projects; and
- undertaking other related ad hoc tasks and assignments as required.

Requirements

- Interest in sports and in the work of the WBSC.
- Currently pursuing or having completed a master's degree in law; a specialisation in sports law is an asset.
- Knowledge of or previous experience in sports law.
- Advanced oral and written communications skills in English.

- Ability to work collaboratively in a multicultural and international environment.
- Fluency in Spanish is an asset.
