Requirements:

Training in computer science or digital humanities at MA level (or equivalent).
Expertise in XML technologies, in particular XQuery.
Expertise in at least one programming language (Python, R).
Knowledge of data analysis and visualisation techniques.
Knowledge of semantic web technologies, in particular ontology engineering.
Familiarity with eXist-DB and TEI encoding is recommended.
Ability to work in a team.

Tasks:

Support to the activities of the SNSF projects *WoPoss* (<https://woposs.unine.ch/>) and *Modality mapping* (<https://data.snf.ch/grants/grant/214102>).

Remuneration:

Legal (CHF 70,864.95 annual for a full-time position according to UniNE scale, with annual increase).
The initial percentage (20%) may be increased.

Starting date:

1 May 2023 or date to be agreed.

Application deadline (initial): 31 March 2023. **The application remains open until a candidate is recruited.**

Duration:

21 months (if one starts on 1 May 2023).
